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Rully Clos du Moulin à Vent, Domaine Anne-Sophie Debavelaere 2006

Anne-Sophie Debavelaere's Rully is bound for my cellar. Honeyed, hazelnut fruit, good acidity. Mini Meursault.

Bylines Hunter Valley Chardonnay, Australia 2008 (6 per case)

This is steeply priced but deservedly so. It's from a joint venture by David Fatches and John Duval, two of Australia's most highly regarded winemakers. Elegant and understated - but with classic development ahead of it in bottle - it's as far from an oaky over-the-top Oz chardy as it's possible to get.

Château de Sours Rosé, Bordeaux 2008

It seems the hype when it comes to this Bordeaux star is justified. "Well-balanced" (RO); "lovely vibrant fruit; dry, long finish" (CH); "lovely texture; creamy red fruits" PC; "crisp, clean fruity palate" (JM) and "good minerality" (JK).

Red Wines

Pavillon du Château Beauchêne, Côtes du Rhône 2007

This is a lovely, almost chillable red, with a fragrant, tangy orange peel edge adding interest to the spicy red berry and pomegranate flavours.

This starts off in dumb and brooding fashion, then emerges to show deep, spicy plum and berry flavours, hints of tar and herbs, and a slightly roasted edge and some dusty minerality to the finish. Very classy, but needs time to show its true colours - so decant it or keep it.

From 8 hectares of clay-limestone soil near Fronsac. Crushed fruit nose with good oak and plum Merlot fruit (50%) backed by firmness of the Cabernets (40% Sauvignon; 10% Franc) this is just opening up to show true Right Bank qualities.

As a négociant, or merchant, based in the northern Côte d'Or in Morey St Denis, Frédéric Magnien is renowned for his fruit-led wines just like this delicious '06. Lap up this sweet, ripe, zesty, damson plum fruit-charged red burgundy, with a touch of leather and chocolate spice on the finish, before everyone else does.
